

Our blended price represents a 17% upside to the latest closing price, with an implied PE'17e of 6.8x and PB'17e of 1.0x. Our rating does not take into account the lack of liquidity in the shares and tight foreign ownership limit of just 5%.

Solid H1'17 performance; Cost control played key role in growing net profit

H1'17 operating income of AED 7.45bn was down by 3%YoY on account of a 12%YoY decline in non-interest income, in spite of a 2%YoY increase in net interest income, which grew because of loan growth despite contracting NIMs (NIMs improved 16 bps QoQ as rate rises flowed into loan yields and funding pressures receded. NIMs tightened 17 bps YoY on higher funding costs). H1'17 non-interest income declined by 12%YoY due to lower one-off gains from sale of investment securities. Operating profit before impairment allowances of AED 5.2bn was flat on YoY basis, benefiting from a tightly managed cost base. H1'17 operating expenses were AED 2.25bn, down by 9% on YoY basis. We expect the bank to maintain cost-to-income at the current level for 2017 and marginally reduce it over 2018F-2021F. Profit before tax & after impairment was up by 5%YoY due to a 13% YoY reduction in Net Impairment Charge. H1'17 Net profit of the bank was up by 5%YoY.



Loan-book expanded by 5%YoY and deposits grew by 7%YoY

The total assets of the bank grew by 8%YoY to AED 259bn and net loans and advances to customers increased by 6%YoY to AED 164bn. Deposits grew 3% YTD and 7%YoY where CASA deposits grew 7%YTD and represent 56% of total deposits. We expect deposit growth to remain in mid-to-high single digit over the forecast period.

Improving asset quality

Provisions of AED 1.26bn improved 13%YoY as cost of risk continues to normalize on the back of improving asset quality metrics. NPL ratio improved to 6.1%, which is still higher than sector average, but provision coverage ratio strengthened to 123.5%.







Key Revisions to Estimates

We have adjusted our estimates for FY17 net loans & deposits, as the recent performance of the bank indicates better-thanexpected growth rates. Credit growth of the entire UAE banking sector was 4.4%YoY until May'17 (Source: CBUAE). System wide deposit growth was 7%YoY until May'17.

In spite of better-than-expected performance, the bank's TP has been reduced in lieu of a slightly higher cost of equity.

We are also expecting net interest margins to continue to improve, as seen in Q2'17, albeit slowly, from here onwards, with other operating income to continue to weigh down on total operating income due to competition in an over-banked market.

TP offers an upside of 17% to CMP; Implies PE'17e of 7.0x and PB'17e of 1.0x

Our target price is based on blended methodology of Dividend Discount Model (80% weight) using a normalized ROE of c13% and a Peer-group P/B valuation (20% weight). Our TP offers an upside of 17% compared to the current market price. We believe that the bank is trading at an attractive PB'17E multiple of 0.9x compared to regional average of 1.4x. The bank's valuation is primarily driven by its strong core operating performance which warrants sustained dividend payouts over the forecast period.

EmiratesNBD is the flagship bank of Dubai (56% owned by the Dubai Government). The bank's sheer size can be estimated by: c16% market share in UAE banking assets, c19% in loans and c18% in deposits, the largest branch network among UAE banks with 156 branches in the country, over 50 of which are Islamic.

Additionally, we believe that the bank's performance will improve as market conditions are expected to pick up with fiscal consolidation, stronger global trade and higher Dubai Expo 2020 investment. The UAE will see non-oil growth hitting 3.3%¹ this year. Real GDP growth is expected to be 1.4% in 2017 and 4.4% in 2018².
